

SNAP FOOD STAMPS

TO APPLY, CALL 215-430-0556

"SNAP" stands for Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program. "SNAP benefits" are the same as food stamps. Benefits are provided each month through a plastic ACCESS Card, which can be used at local grocery stores and farmers markets.

Households with **members age 60+**, or who are receiving SSI or SSD benefits can have higher incomes and still get benefits.

Documented immigrants often qualify for SNAP if they have lived in the country for 5+ years with a green card, or are children under age 18.

College students may qualify for SNAP benefits if the student is enrolled in Federal Work-Study, works 20+ hours per week, has a dependent under the age of 13, or is over age 50.

To be eligible, you must be a PA resident and seen by a health professional at a WIC clinic. You may receive WIC benefits even if you work, receive other benefits, or are undocumented.
